

### Online Survey to Understand Impact of Covid-19 on Citizens of Sri Lanka

In partnership with **The World Bank**, Safetipin is conducting an online assessment to understand the impact of Covid-19 on the life of citizens of Sri Lanka. The survey aims to capture differences in travel patterns, mobility choices and overall well-being of the citizens due to Covid-19. The responses will be analysed to suggest recommendations for making public spaces and transport in Sri Lanka both Covid and gender responsive.

#### Safety Mapping in Panaji, Goa

Safetipin in partnership with Tandem research, Goa has started collecting data in Panaji, Goa using Safetipin Nite application in the month of January 2021. On 20th of January, 2021, the team from Safetipin conducted a training for the functioning of Safetipin Nite application to the team of Tandem Research, volunteers and drivers. The data collection will continue till the last week of February.

#### Raahgiri Day on Anath Road

On 30th January, 2021, there was a Raahgiri day on Anath Road in Sector 18, Gurugram organised by Raahgiri Foundation. This 2.5km stretch of road is going to be converted into a green belt by the GMDA in the coming months. Safetipin conducted an activity at the event where people were asked to share their views about the street and mention the changes they would like to see. It was an interactive event with people of all ages participating. We got inputs on the lighting in the area, the security as well as the waste management and drainage systems in place. We also conducted another activity in which the participants had to guess the safety score of the road and the people who got the closest values, won Safetipin prizes.
